### **Delivery and Time Commitment**

The ESFA apprenticeship funding requires candidates to allocate a minimum of 20% of their contractual working hours to the programme (This includes learning related activities in the workplace) over each 24-36 month programme period.

The blended programme would be delivered as follows:

- Skills4Stem eLearning online eLearning (24/7)
- Skills4Stem workbooks
- 1 full day (9.30am – 4.30pm) face-to-face training session delivered once a month
- 1 full day (9.30am – 4.30pm) face-to-face workshop delivered once a month
- Unlimited 1-2-1 remote support by Skills4Stem qualified practitioner trainers

### **Employer Mentor**

Candidates would also be assigned to a workplace mentor provider by the employer to debrief with regularly for the whole development programme. The candidates will also be asked to create a comprehensive portfolio of evidence for their Portfolio element which will be signed off at the end of each month by their mentor & Skills4Stem allocated Assessor.

### **Costs & Funding**

- Levels 4 = £8,000 per year **FULLY FUNDED** by the Apprenticeship Levy
- Candidates Employed Salary
- Internal mentoring resource to support the programme.
